RESURRECTING OUR ROADS

The asset value of South Africa's road network is very large – so much so that if road authorities in the country were privately listed as companies they would feature in the "Fortune 500" listing. As such roads are "big business" and need to be properly managed. Unfortunately this has not been the case for the majority of our provincial road network and much of our municipal road network.

The consequence of this is tens of billions of Rand in excess road user costs and probably many unnecessary road deaths, being incurred annually.

In an attempt to address this unfortunate state of affairs, caused primarily by deficiencies in finance, expertise and good management in many road authorities the South African Road Federation has initiated an endeavour to promote a systems approach to road management, incorporating good governance by road authorities.

Towards this end a seminar on road pavement management will be held in Gauteng on 21 July and in addition, in conjunction with the International Road Federation, a three day conference devoted to preserving Africa's road network will be held in Cape Town during October this year.
