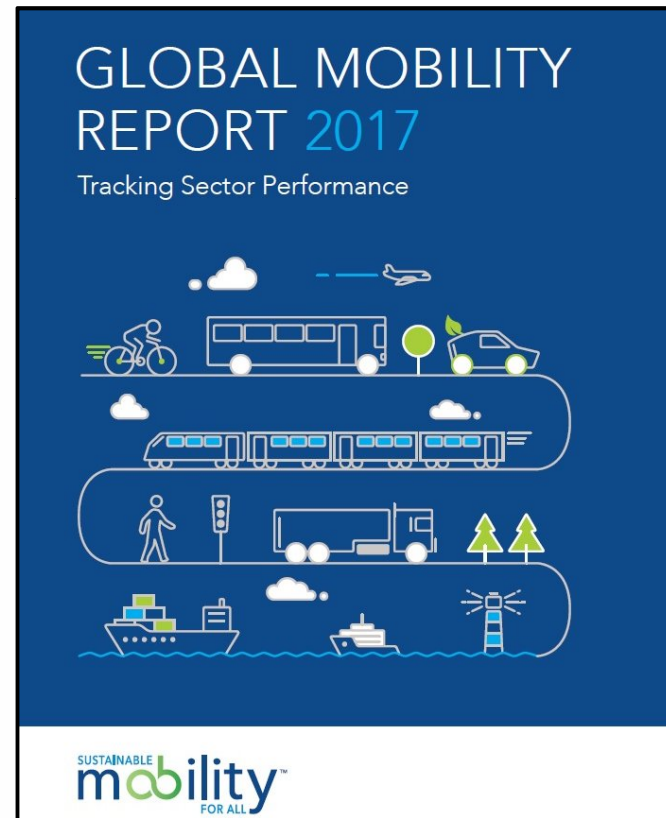

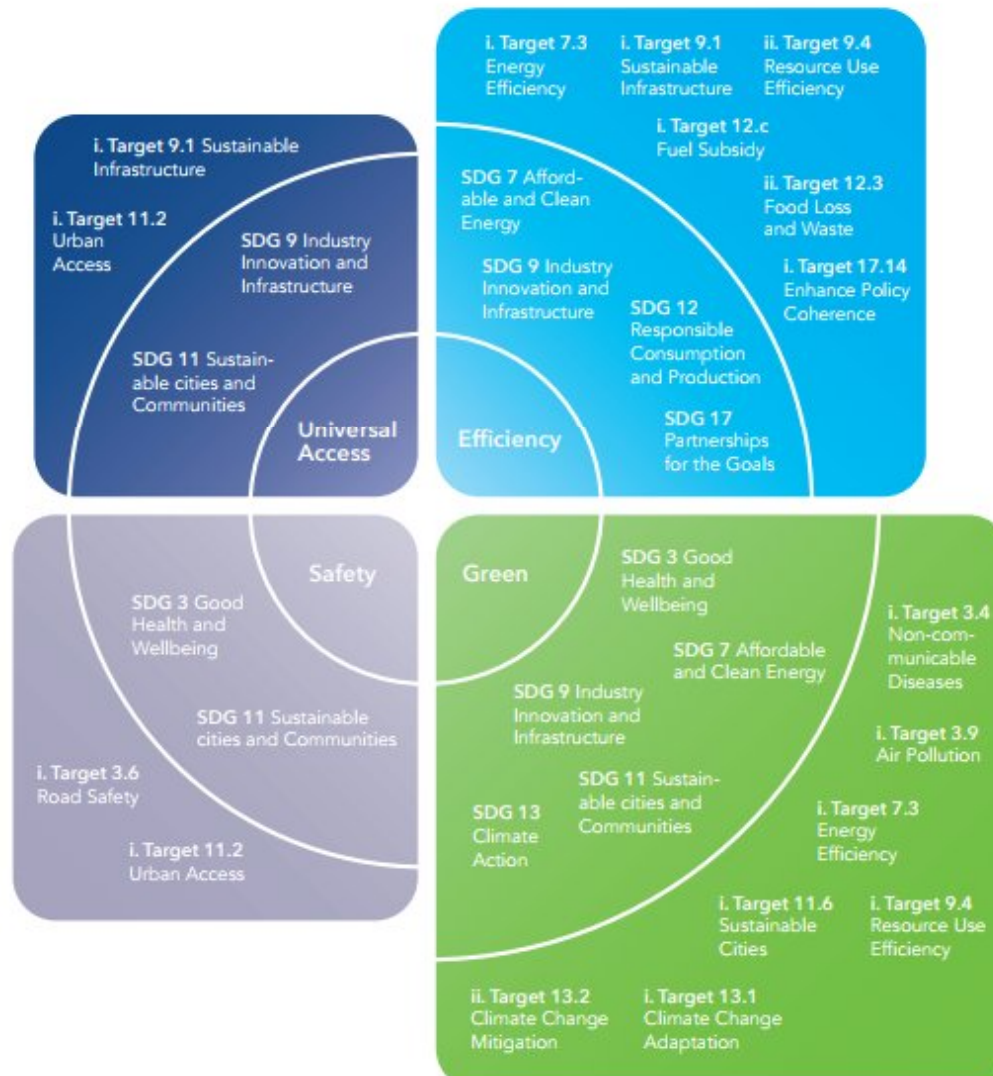

GLOBAL OBJECTIVES



UNIVERSAL ACCESS

Ensure for all equitable access to economic & social opportunities by 2030, leaving "no one behind"



EFFICIENCY

Increase the efficiency of the transport systems by 2030



SAFETY

Improve safety of mobility across transport modes



GREEN

Shift transport systems to low polluting (GHG/air/noise) and climate resilient path

Synergies (co-benefits) and trade offs
