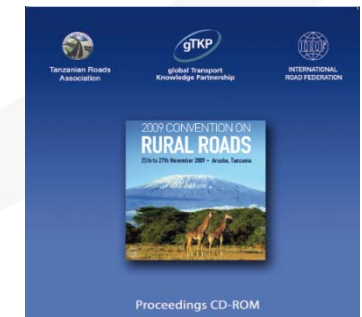
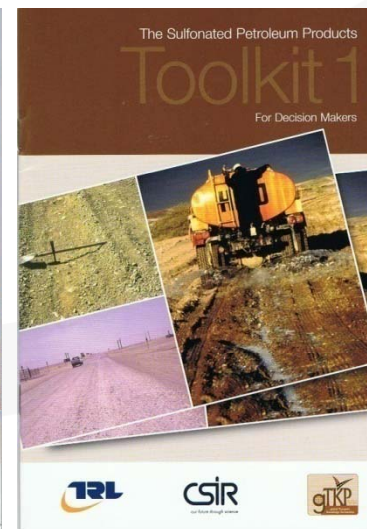
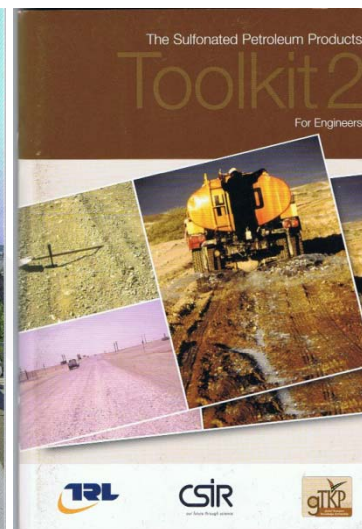
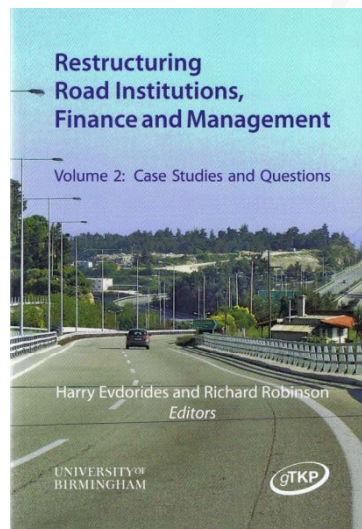
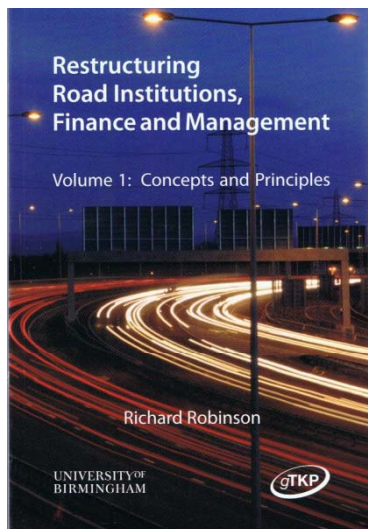
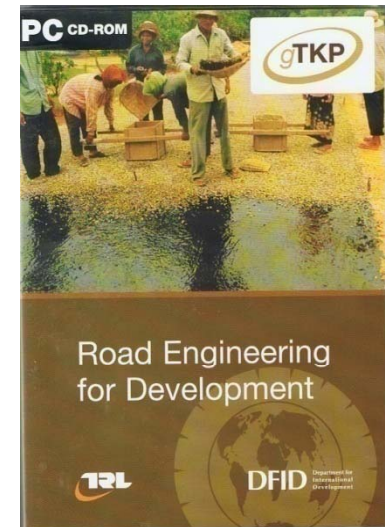
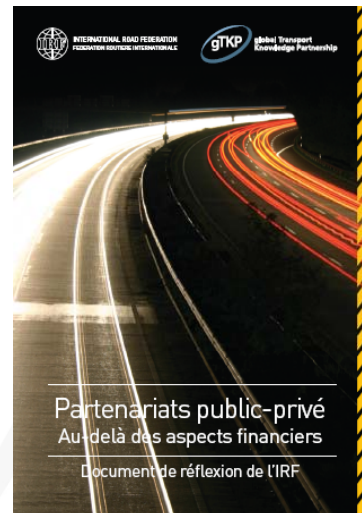
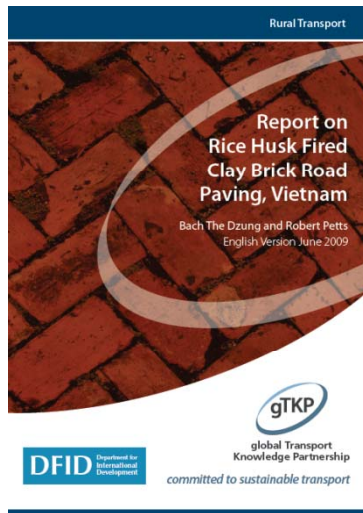


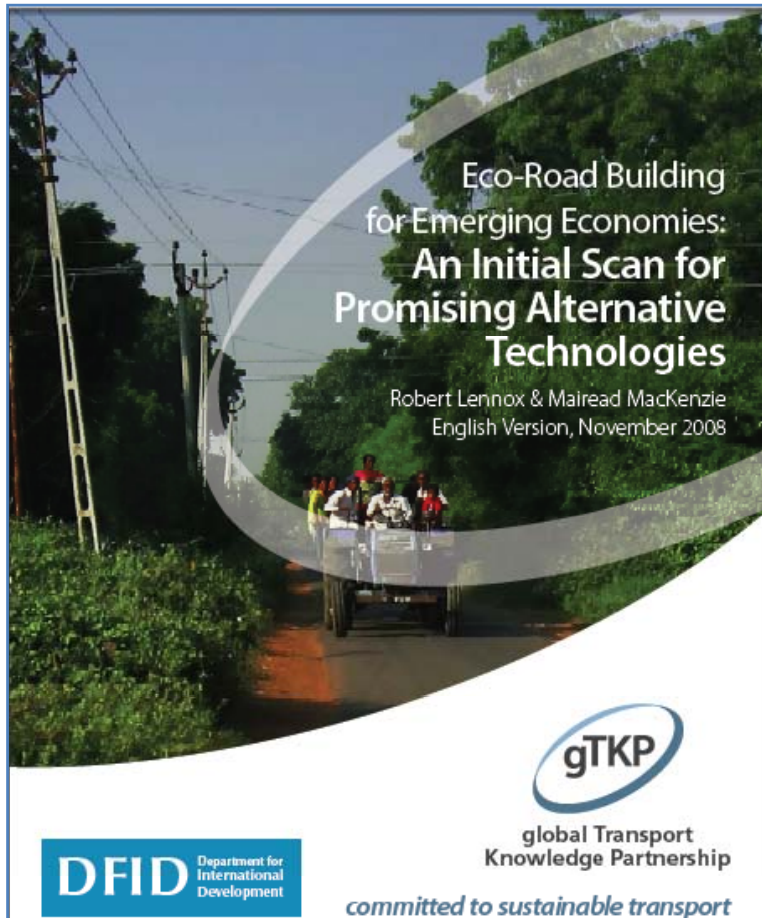


Partnership on Sustainable Low Carbon Transport

 - Integration of SLCT in climate change negotiations
 - Integration of climate considerations in regional, national and local transport policies
- **Guiding principles:**
 - Non legal, non binding;
 - Decentralized structure;
 - Implementation of Partnership activities is up to partner members;
- **Geographical focus:** developing countries in Africa, Asia and Latin America
- **Thematic focus:** Land transport (passengers and freight)
